### From Ogden Canyon

Turn left at 4-way stop (Valley  
Market) in Eden and drive for **2.9  
miles** to 4100 N. where there is a 3-  
way stop . Turn left and travel West  
for **.2 miles**. Turn right on 3300 E.  
and travel North for **1.3 miles**. Turn  
left on 5100 N. and drive West **1.5  
miles** to the parking lot.

Extreme Weather Clothing (no cotton)  
GPS *AND* Compass  
Helmet  
Headlamp  
Snowshoes  
Goggles / Sunglasses  
Notebook / Pencil

### From North Ogden Divide

Turn left on 3300 E. in Liberty like  
you were headed to Avon and North  
Fork Park. Travel North for **1.3 miles**.  
Turn left on 5100 N. and drive West  
the **1.5 miles** to the parking lot. Park  
your vehicle there and walk the **.5  
miles** to the Environmental Center.
